

EQUIPMENT LIST FOR CAMPERS - - - SHORT SESSION 2008
PLEASE BRING EVERYTHING WE RECOMMEND
BE SURE THAT ALL ITEMS ARE WELL MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

Clothing: We suggest using old clothing that the camper already has – **labeled with the camper's name**

- 3 pr. jeans or long pants
- 2-3 pr. of shorts
- 4-6 shirts, either long or *short sleeve
- 2 warm sweaters (at least one polar fleece, *sweatshirts, or pile) - hood optional
- 5-7 pr. of socks
- 5-7 sets of underwear
- 1-2 sets of pajamas
- 1-2 bathing suits/swim trunks
- 1 warm parka or jacket (older is better)
- 1 set of rain gear (jacket, pants and hat) or rain poncho (very important)**
- For Dances - skirt and blouse or dress for girls
- sport shirt and pants or jeans for boys

"There is no such thing as bad weather, only inappropriate clothing."

Hats:

- *1 wool/pile type
- 1 visor style cap (baseball)

Footwear:

- 2-3 pr. tennis shoes and/or
- lightweight hiking boots (If you have them.
- If you do not have them do not purchase just for camp)

Toiletries and personal supplies - clearly mark these items with camper's name

Please – no hairdryers, curling irons or appliances with heating elements

- 1 Dormitory Trunk – not exceeding 22" in height (those with wheels may suffer damage)
- *1 laundry bag
- 1 small pillow
- 2 pillowcases
- 2 bath towels
- 1- 2 washcloths
- 1 sleeping bag, lightweight (4-6 lbs) but warm
(should be washable in a standard machine if bed wetting could be an issue)
- *Personal hygiene items - toothpaste, soap, shampoo, etc (should include soap dish, sun block, insect repellent). Best to have these in a small bag or plastic container that can be carried to/left in shower house.
- *pen/stationery/stamps
- 3-4 clothes hangers

Camping equipment - clearly mark these items with camper's name

- *1 camp cook kit with silverware and cup
- 1 flashlight with *batteries
- 1 daypack
- *1 water bottle

OPTIONAL

- musical instruments (packed to avoid breakage or in protective case)
- camera and *film
- inexpensive watch/jewelry
- sunglasses
- 1 camp knife with can opener (**label with camper's name**)
- 1 pr. rubber boots
- 1 pr water sandals or shoes
- 1 old wool blanket for bed and campfire use

* Limited Supply Available at Camp Store

DO NOT SEND: Matches, lighters, candles, incense, aerosol products of any kind, or knives larger than a typical Swiss Army style pocketknife. Campers also may not have money, iPods, walkmans, radios or other electronic gear at camp. Such items, if they bring them, must be turned in on the first day of camp and will be returned on the last day.

LABEL EVERYTHING YOU'D LIKE RETURNED
