

## WFA COURSE TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

**WILDERNESS FIRST AID STUDENTS must arrive by early evening Sunday, June 8<sup>th</sup>. We assume people will arrive on the 5:25pm ferry out of Anacortes that arrives in Friday Harbor at 6:30pm and we will provide transportation assistance geared toward that arrival time.**

### COMING WITHOUT A CAR

#### TRANSPORTATION FROM SEATTLE DIRECT TO THE SAN JUANS:

- Flights from Seattle/Tacoma Airport: ALL SHUTTLES MUST BE RESERVED IN ADVANCE. Seaplanes have a baggage limit of 25# that will not allow you to bring a trunk. All fares subject to change.
- Kenmore Airlines (800) 543-9595 ([www.kenmoreair.com](http://www.kenmoreair.com)) flies fixed wing to Friday Harbor and seaplanes to Roche Harbor from Sea-Tac Airport.
- Fixed wing flights depart from Boeing Field. Kenmore offers a free shuttle from Sea-Tacoma Airport to Boeing Field. One-way approximately \$112.00. Round trip + shuttle \$224.00.
- Seaplane flights depart from downtown Seattle (Lake Union). Kenmore offers free shuttle connections from Sea-Tacoma Airport. One-way \$143.00. Round trip \$246.00.

#### BOAT TRANSPORTATION FROM SEATTLE TO SAN JUANS:

- **The Victoria Clipper: 1-800-888-2535, ([www.victoriaclipper.com](http://www.victoriaclipper.com))** runs daily from downtown Seattle at 7:45 am arriving Friday Harbor at 11:15 am.& then departs Friday Harbor 4:30 pm arriving Seattle at 7:15 p.m. One-way fare is \$42.50; round trip \$72.50.

### TRANSPORTATION FROM SEATTLE TO ANACORTES FERRY TERMINAL

**Shuttle:** There is no Greyhound Bus service to Anacortes or the ferry landing.

- **Airporter Shuttle: 1-866-235-5247 (<http://www.airporter.com>)** operates from Sea-Tac airport to the ferry landing. Shuttles leave in the morning at 5:55,6:55,7:55, 8:55, & 10:55am. Afternoon at 12:55, 2:55, 4:55, & 6:55pm. It is approx. a 3 hour trip. \$33.00 One-way, \$61.00 round trip. Prepaid reservations are required 4 days in advance. You will need to catch one of the first shuttles to make a same day connection with the designated ferry departure. When making your reservation confirm that it will allow you to make the 5:25pm ferry.

- There will be a ferry leaving Anacortes for Friday Harbor, San Juan Island at 5:25pm. If you are having someone drive you to Anacortes allow no less than 2 hours driving time from the Seattle area.
- A passenger ticket for the ferry will cost approximately \$12.00. This is a round trip ticket, so your ride back to the mainland is free.

**Camp vans will meet the ferry in Friday Harbor at approximately 6:30 p.m. to transport participants who need rides to Roche Harbor.**

**ISLAND TRANSPORTATION- IF YOU MISS THE CAMP VAN PICK-UP**

San Juan Taxi Service (360) 378-3550 has a one-way for one person \$20.00, and then it's \$2.00 for each additional person up to four. They meet most ferries. You must call in advance to guarantee that they meet you at the ferry landing. All fares are subject to change.

**COMING WITH A CAR**

**\*\*\*If you are a Nor'wester Staff Member coming with a car, please refer to your Arrival and Transportation Bulletin for Parking Information\*\*\***

- Overnight parking is available at Roche Harbor. Parking passes are generally purchased from the Hotel Registration Desk.
- There will be a ferry leaving Anacortes for Friday Harbor, San Juan Island at 5:25pm. It allows you to meet your arrival requirements.
- The cost to bring a car on the ferry will be approximately \$70.00. This is a round trip fee, so your ride back to the mainland is free. **(See Staff Checklist for fare discount information).**
- **Allow two hours** driving time from Seattle to the Anacortes landing and **arrive 1 hour before the scheduled ferry departure**. There is tremendous car traffic on the ferries and you can easily be left behind, waiting 3-4 hours for the next boat. The ferry ride from Anacortes to Friday Harbor, San Juan Island varies from one-and-one-half to two hours depending on the number of stops it makes at other islands. The ferry we recommend is a non-stop directly to Friday Harbor.

**TRANSPORTATION FROM ROCHE HARBOR TO JOHNS ISLAND**

At Roche Harbor, we will provide transportation to Johns Island. The tentative departure time from Roche Harbor is 7:15 PM. You are responsible for meeting the boat on time. It departs from slip E-1 on the right hand side of the dock has you walk out toward the water. Look for someone with a small sign that says "NORWESTER".
