**ENROLLMENT**

- All applications will be processed on a "first come, first served" basis. Early application is recommended since enrollment is limited to 60 individuals.
- To enroll, fill out and sign the enclosed application form, and return it with your total tuition plus the \$50 deposit to the camp store. Upon acceptance, we will send you an acknowledgement and suggested clothing lists and other pertinent information will follow.

**TUITIONS:**

Family Camp: \$300/person 7 years and older  
\$175/per child between the ages of 3 and 6  
\$50/family as deposit for store purchases

**At least one child must be 7-12 years old** – All children attending must be at least 3 years old  
Fee includes round trip transportation between Anacortes and Johns Island.

Please enclose full amount due with this application. This check will be returned if this application is not accepted. There will be a \$25.00 service charge per family for cancellations made before May 1<sup>st</sup>. No refund of tuitions will be made for cancellations after that date. Reservations cannot be guaranteed if full tuition does not accompany the application.

**FOCUS OF PROGRAM:** The focus of ENW is to introduce families with young (7-12) children to our program and site. Please be aware that activities are limited for those 3-6 years old.

**PLANNED ACTIVITIES:** May include (but are not limited to): canoeing, hiking, sailing, kayaking, arts and crafts, campfires, challenge course, archery, nature studies and work projects.

**TRADING POST:** The Trading Post carries such items as stamps, writing materials, toiletries, candy, juice, and film. Camp sweatshirts and T-shirts are also available on a limited basis. Families will be allowed to charge items against their deposit at the store. After camp is over, any credit balances will be refunded, any outstanding charges will be billed.

**TRANSPORTATION:** All families will be transported directly to Johns Island by charter boat from Anacortes, Washington. Transportation fees are included in the tuition charges.

**CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT:** No special clothing or equipment is required. Clothing suitable for cool mornings/evenings is recommended, as is some form of rain gear and closed toed shoes. Old luggage that will slide under the camp beds is best (approximately 14-16" high). Each person needs to bring his or her own sleeping bag, pillow, towel, flashlight and toiletry items. The camp will provide a bed frame and a mattress.

**HEALTH AND SAFETY:** Our resident doctor and/or registered nurse is available 24 hours a day, and consults with an island physician when appropriate. If there is any cause for concern, family camp participants can be taken to a physician for diagnosis and treatment.

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**ACCIDENT AND ILLNESS:** Every precaution is taken to protect campers from illness and accident through supervision, adequate equipment, proper food, rest, and sanitation. However, accidents and illness do occur now and then under even the most careful auspices. Doctor or medical bills resulting from injury or sickness are the responsibility of the registered parent or guardian.

**DIETARY NEEDS:** Our meals have been reviewed by a registered dietician and are designed to meet the nutritional needs of session participants. There will be meals where the major source of protein is meat. Vegans and people with allergies to many foods may need to bring specialized items with them. Please call the camp office if you have questions about the content of meals being served during the session.

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

- The camp has only cellular telephones and use is limited to emergencies only. **Individual cellular phone service is erratic; use is discouraged and will be restricted to certain areas of camp.**
- Parents are asked not to bring any food, chewing gum, lighters, electronic games, CD players, radios or aerosol products to camp. These items are considered "contraband".
- Smoking, drugs, alcoholic beverages, and improper use of fire are strictly forbidden at camp. Violation of these rules will result in immediate dismissal of the registered family from camp without refund.
- Pets are not allowed. There are domestic and wild animals at camp for the enjoyment of participants.

A FINAL BULLETIN containing travel instructions and other details will be mailed to enrolled families by June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Explore Nor'wester is a very special event and we are looking forward to spending that time with you and your family.
